How To Apply for an Infundo Ephakemeyo Scholarship:

Each year the Infundo Ephakemeyo Scholarship Fund (a registered charity with the government of Canada) offers several post-secondary scholarships and awards to youth of Zimbabwean heritage.

The scholarships and awards are determined on a competitive basis and require;

- the submission of an essay,
- a statement of need,
- transcript/credit counseling summary,
- an offer and acceptance of admission by a post-secondary institution.

All students of Zimbabwean heritage are invited to participate in this process.

The Application Process:

There are four components to the application package. Each component is outlined below.

1. **ESSAY** - Each applicant must submit a 300-500-word essay stating why he/she deserves the scholarship. In the essay, the applicant must identify the post-secondary institution he/she has been accepted into, as well as the intended program of study.
2. **LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION** - Each applicant is required to submit two letters of recommendation from individuals meeting the following criteria:
 - a) One letter from a current or former educator familiar with the applicant's abilities and academic record and abilities and your academics;
 - b) One letter from a community member describing the applicant's contributions to her/his community.
3. **TRANSCRIPT(S)** - The applicant must submit a copy of her/his official high school transcript.
4. **OFFICIAL APPLICATION FORM** (attached to this application)

DEADLINE

All application documents must be sent by June 30 to be considered for the upcoming school year starting in September. Successful applicants will be notified by mid-July and will be recognized after the annual golf tournament
